Welding Supplies – Bid in process, however Chuck is waiting for the consortium buyer to come on board to assist.

Electronics Recycling – Extended bid to 2/18/10. Discussed how pending legislation could affect this program – retailers may be required to take back old items or municipalities may be forced to operate collection sites – waiting to see what happens with the legislation on this.

Law Enforcement Vehicles – Crowne Vic, Dodge Chargers bid is being extended. Recommending to buy Chevy's from state bid.

Vehicles & Light Trucks – Participation documents available on website. Notice has been sent

out to agencies, however timeline on commitment may be extended somewhat for budget process.

Sidewalk Salt – Will be quote out with piggyback language.

Softener Salt – Have verbal agreement with vendor to extend bid for one more year. Waiting for this in writing.

Group discussed how piggyback bid opportunities should be given to Karen so she can list on contracts listing.
